The Board & Executive Teams

Are you comfortable with the frequency and level of IP&C data being reported to Executive Teams?Yes / No
Is the IP&C 'voice" heard (via succinct papers and business cases) at an executive level when resources are required?Yes / No
Are you supported by Executive and Communication Teams when launching IP&C related campaigns such has hand hygiene and antibiotic initiatives?Yes / No
Are you supported by Executive Teams when beds need to be closed to control outbreaks (following a comprehensive risk assessment?)
If beds are reopened due to severe bed pressures – do you have Executive support to close the beds again when immediate pressures have eased?Yes / No
